**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE MICHAEL NEIER AS THE SENIOR CLASS VICE
PRESIDENT POSITION**

**WITH THE GENERAL STUDIES STUDENT COUNCIL FOR THE 2015-2016
ACADEMIC YEAR**

WHEREAS Michael Neier is of junior standing, having earned a total of 88 credits as of June 2015; and

WHEREAS Michael Neier has fulfilled all other requirements of eligibility as stated in the GSSC

constitution and bylaws; and

WHEREAS Michael Neier is extremely committed to the GSSC and GS community as a whole, and has

continuously demonstrated this commitment during his service as First Year President during the 2014-

2015 academic year; and

WHEREAS the candidate is exemplary and qualified for the position given his prior experience, work

ethic, and institutional knowledge; and

WHEREAS the candidate and his advisor confirm that he is of senior standing, on track to graduate in

either May or December 2016;

ACKNOWLEDGING that according to GSSC bylaws, Article III. Section 3. Candidate Eligibility, a

candidate for the Senior Class Vice President position must be of senior standing, as defined by the DOS

Office (having at least 90 credits at the time of starting the position), for the entirety of the upcoming

academic year.

ACKNOWLEDGING that this occurrence is not a conventional case and should be treated as an

exception, not a rule;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the General Studies Student Council allows Michael Neier, with 88

credits, to enter the position of Senior Class Vice President for the upcoming 2015-2016 academic year in

order to support best interests and objectives of the GSSC, the senior year class, and the GS community

as a whole.
